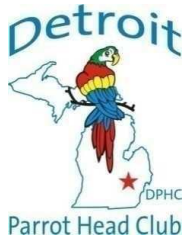

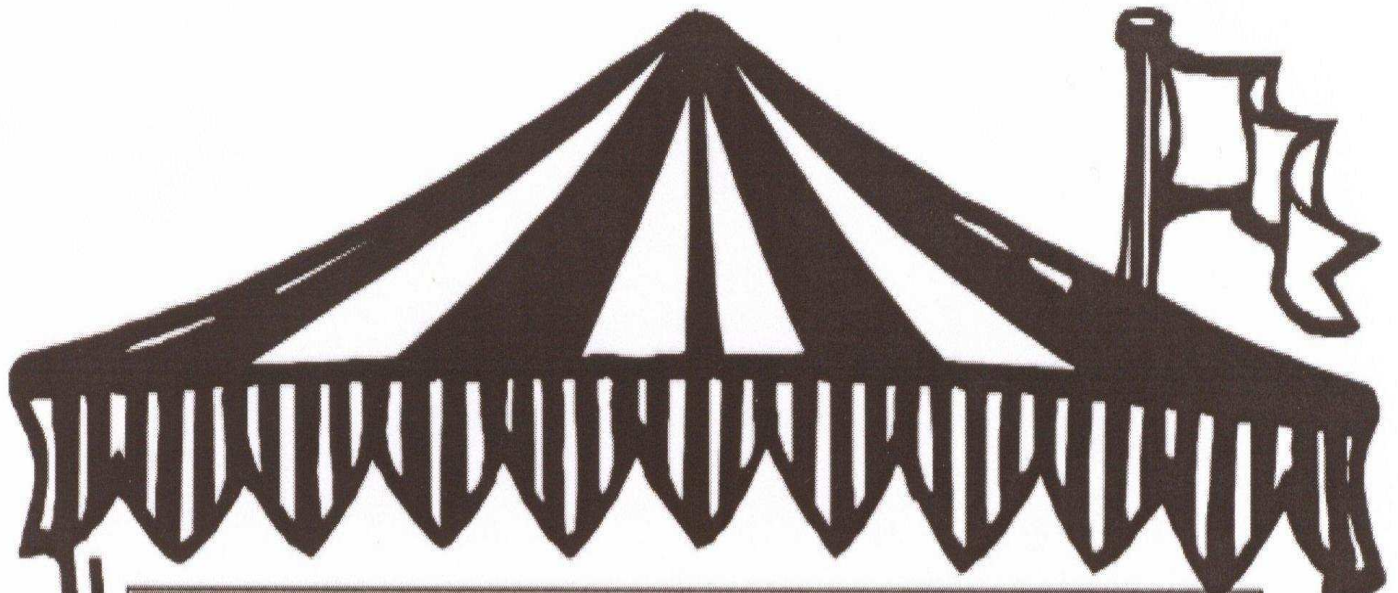

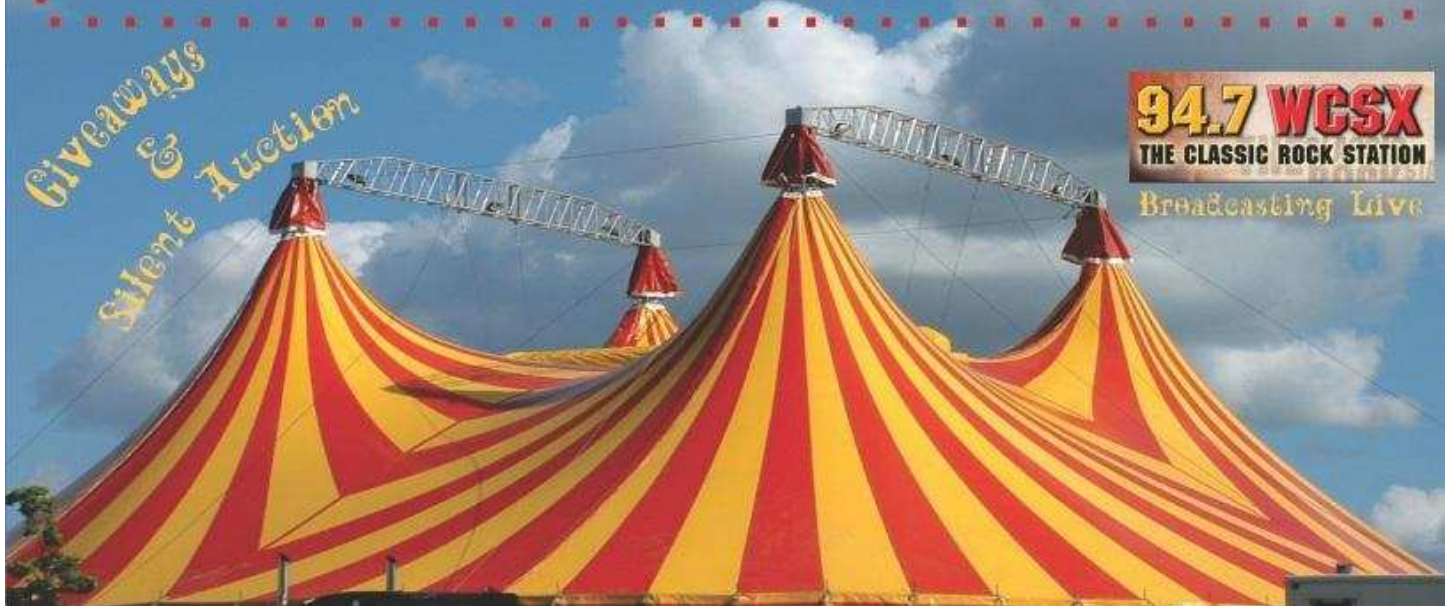

Oh what a Relay! 24 hours, \$4341.00 raised by the team, 9 dedicated walkers, and a lifetime of memories of hope created. I arrived at Ab-Nab-Awen Park in Grand Rapids around 11am to meet fellow DPHC member Jen Hunt and the rest of our team. After dragging all of my worldly possessions out to the site (you never know what you might need) we got it set up just in time for the first lap! The relay lapped the grounds of the Gerald R. Ford presidential library and museum and walked directly down the beautiful Grand River. 7pm began the survivors lap where we celebrated John Hunt, Jen's dad, as he made his way around after his courageous battle with cancer (He won by the way, take that cancer!). As the sun set the luminaries were placed around the track and loved ones come down to light their remembrances of those who had lost their battle and to celebrate those who are still fighting this horrible disease. Walking past all of those names thinking of all of those families and friends, men and women dedicated to their communities, churches, country and family, people who will be missed by so many. This is one of the most touching parts of this event and the thing that pulls me to relay every year. Watching the men and women that walk the full 24 hours of their own choice hobble past at 4am pushes *you* to go one more lap before turning it over to someone else. The kids with hats and scarves over their heads walking right alongside their parents gives *you* the strength to push on. Knowing that one night of walking helped raise \$29,750.87 for the American Cancer Society, before you go home to crash, makes the sacrifice completely worth it. Jen Hunt and I both thank you all for your support of this event and your generosity and we look forward to walking for the club next year here in Detroit!

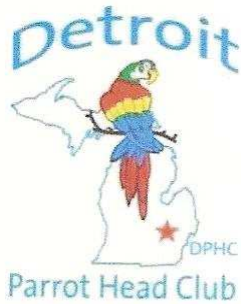

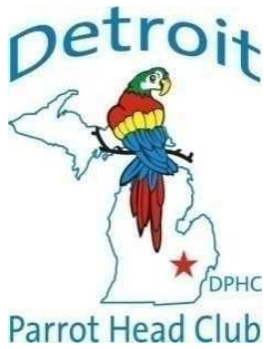
